Center Township Board of Supervisors September 8, 2020 Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, September 8, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Paul Cook, Vice Chairman, Harry Gillispie, Supervisor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Visitors were Dave and Cheryl Brendel.

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Paul Cook and the Pledge of Allegience was recited.

Paul made a motion to approve the August meeting minutes as read. Harry seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Harry made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Dave and Cheryl Brendel gave an update on the spotted lantern fly traps set at the park. None have been found to date. Mrs. Brendel stated that they will lay their eggs in October, which looks like a glob of mud. The eggs will hatch mid spring as a black and white spotted bug. As they mature they eat so much vegetation they leave large sticky droppings on outdoor furniture, vehicles and plants. The droppings can kill the plants.

Clean Up Week will be held from October 5th through the 10th.

The new slide at the playground has been installed and is being enjoyed.

The old restrooms at the playground have been demolished and the new restroom facilities and pavilion are under construction. The project should be completed in October.

The oiling and chipping of the roadways was completed. It was decided not to purchase the flex pave sealant for several places where there are grades with turns and the E3 and No. 8 gravel will not hold. At the suggestion of the oil supplier layers of oil in combination with No. 67 aggregate and No. 8 aggregate were placed in the trouble areas.

The town-wide yard sale was held on Sept. 5th.

At the request of the Greene County Tax Claim Bureau Paul made a motion to exonerate three mobile homes from back taxes and removed from the tax books as they are no longer located in the township. Harry seconded and the motion was carried.

Paul made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Harry and the meeting was adjourned at 7:13 p.m.
