

# **CORRESPONDENCE**

Environmental Review for Whites Ridge Water Line Extension- Franklin Township

Ms. Hlatky explained the District received a request from Greene County Planning and
Community Development for the District's input regarding prime farmland or farmland of
statewide or local importance as regulated under the Farmland Protection Act. This request is
required as part of the G.C. Community Development Block Grant Program. Ms. Hlatky reviewed
the project maps and determined the project will not interfere with prime farmland.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

Mr. Schweiger explained the District is waiting on the check from the state for the William A. Cree, Jr. and Lura Ann Cree #3 farm to move forward with the closing.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

## Dominick & Kimberly Barbetta #1 (79.175 ac.) - LESA score: 50.97

Mr. Schweiger explained the offer letter was revised to include a signature page and was sent to Mr. and Mrs. Barbetta. Mr. and Mrs. Barbetta are in attendance of the meeting and intend on signing the letter this day. Mr. and Mrs. Barbetta chose Option A (\$1,500/acre based on the plotted acreage). Mr. Schweiger explained the clear title has not been completed and Mr. Hook is actively working on it.

## William A. Cree, Jr. & Lura Ann Cree #3 (83.029 ac.)- LESA Score: 59.47

Mr. Schweiger explained the District has not heard back from the state and they are processing on their end. Mr. Schweiger stated Ms. Hlatky has documented some of the incidentals and those will be completed soon once confirmed.

### Request to Suspend the 2021 Application Period

A motion was made by Richard Belding to send a temporary application suspension request letter to the PDA Bureau of Farmland Preservation. Richard Thistlethwaite seconded. (Motion passed)

# 2021 Directorship recommendation to Greene County Commissioners

A brief discussion was held in regards to the upcoming 2021 directorship recommendation to Greene County Commissioners.

A motion was made by Chris Eisiminger to recommend reappointment to the expiring members: Richard Belding, James Willis, and Mike Belding. Richard Belding seconded. (Motion passed)

A motion was made by Chris Eisiminger to recommend reappointment of William Cree III as Chairman. Richard Thistlethwaite seconded. (Motion passed)

#### **Agreement of Sale-Barbetta**

Mr. and Mrs. Barbetta agreed on signing the Agreement of Sale installment option. A brief discussion was held in regards to the interest rate to be offered for the purchase of Dominick and Kimberly Barbetta's easement. Interest rates were discussed last year with comparison of the interest rate of local banks.

A motion was made by Richard Thistlethwaite to pay 1% interest to the Barbetta's annually. Mike Belding seconded. (Motion passed)

# Advertise to suspend 2020-2021 application period

A motion was made by Richard Belding to advertise to suspend 2020-2021 application period. Mike Belding seconded. (Motion passed)

## Surface coal preliminary screening

District staff explained the importance of keeping potential applicants in mind while the application period is suspended. A discussion was held regarding the process of conducting

preliminary surface coal screening to determine eligibility once the application period resumes. With the application period suspended, applications will not be suspended but files would be kept on inquiring applicants with preliminary screening to determine eligibility.

A motion was made by Mike Belding to conduct preliminary screening to determine eligibility of future applicants. Richard Thistlethwaite seconded. (Motion passed)
