Center Township Board of Supervisors September 14, 2021 Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, September 14, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Edward A. "Butch" Deter, Chairman, Paul Cook, Vice Chairman, Harry Gillispie, Supervisor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Visitors were Daniel Stoneking and Glenn Eddy.

Harry made a motion to approve the minutes of the August business meeting as read. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Harry made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 1-2021 updating the weight limit ordinance. Harry seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

There were no code enforcement updates. We are still awaiting a decision of the proposal given to Ms. Lowery for the non-compliance of trash pick-up at 120 Second Street.

The engineers report was reviewed. Lucas Electric will begin the electrical upgrades at the sewer plant next week.

Paul made a motion to give conditional approval of the lot split for the Redevelopment Authority property on Third Street. The condition being that catch basins be placed at the corner of School Street and Plum Alley and the corner of Peach Alley and Plum Alley. Once installed the down spouts for the existing townhomes and the new proposed homes are to be run to the catch basins. Harry seconded the lot split with conditional approval. Motion carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion at adopt Resolution No. 3-2021 revising the 2021 Budget to reflect the receipt of the American Rescue Plan funds and the Impact Fee funds. Harry seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Clean Up Week is scheduled for the week of October 4th through the 9th. Collection times were discussed and it was decided to wait to set the times.

Paul made a motion to purchase 480 feet of 8" waterline for the public water extension from the Franklin Township line on White's Ridge Road on to Hoy Hill Road. Harry seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Harry made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Paul and the meeting was adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
