

GREENE COUNTY PRISON BOARD MINUTES

September 16th 2021

The Greene County Prison Board meeting was brought to order at 11:45 am by Chairman Mike Belding in the first-floor meeting room of the County office building. Others in attendance were: Commissioner Betsy McClure, Chief Clerk Jeff Marshall, Sarah Penich, Warden John Kingston, Deputy Jerad Cline, and Ami Cree. Lou Dayich and Dave Russo joined by phone

MOTIONS

1. Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Ami Cree the second to approve the minutes from the August 19th 2021 Prison Board meeting. Vote unanimous.

SECURITY

1. There were four (4) reportable Extraordinary Occurrence Reports (EOR) submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections for the Month of August 2021.
2. The facility issued twenty (20) major misconducts and eight (8) minor misconducts for the month of August 2021.
3. The average daily population for August was seventy-one (71) with fifty-eight (58) being the lowest number and ninety (90) being the highest.

TREATMENT

1. The facility hosted men's Bible study presented by Landmark Baptist Church on 8-3,8-10,8-17,8-24, and 8-31 2021.
2. Haircuts were conducted on 8-4 and 8-18 2021.
3. The Domestic Violence Group met on 8-9 2021.
4. The First Assembly Church will be conducting Women's Bible

Study at a date yet to be determined.

5. As of 9-14-2021, we are suspending all volunteers' groups until further notice.

STAFFING AND TRAINING

1. Corrections Officer Josh Galbraith started on 8-23 and Food Service Worker Sharon Phillips started on 9-1-2021.
2. Staff TASER certifications were conducted on 9-7, 9-13, and 9-15-2021.

MAINTENANCE

The Work Crew will be assisting with preparations for the White Covered Bridge Festival and continue to perform internal maintenance needs relative to the upcoming state audit.

FINANCIAL REPORT

1. The August assessed revenue report generated from the Greene County Central Booking Center was \$4,900.00 with \$2,906.79 being an actual paid return for the month.
2. The August assessed administrative fees were \$1,229.00 with \$569.20 being collected.
3. Washington County owes \$8,850.00 for the month of August and currently owes \$7,950.00 for the month of September.
