Mr. Kelly introduced Ms. Karen Gleason from Stahl Shaeffer, representing the project-

Ms. Gleason noted that the Conditional Final Approval is subject to the successful obtainment of the 105/106 permitting through the PA DEP. The 106/105 permits are required due to the projects location in the floodplain. A study is done to ensure that there is little to no impact to the floodplain. It was also determined that the VFD was a public entity; as such they are required to do a 106 permit, along with a 105 permit.

Mr. Goroncy asked how the design requirements differ between not having a 106/105 permit and having one.

Ms. Gleason noted that the requirements are not that different; all projects are designed in such a way that they minimize impacts on downstream neighbors and minimize affects on environmental issues.

Mr. Goroncy asked what requirements will be needed by the PADEP for submittal.

Ms. Gleason noted that an H & H study will be required, with an E & S approval, Act 14 notifications, PNDI, historic review, SWM approvals and the application itself.

Mr. Stratton made a motion for Conditional Approval based on obtaining necessary permits and the design of the plan does not change, seconded by Ms. Knapik. All were in favor and the Conditonal Final was approved.
