Recommended Action

Recommended Action

Pursuant to the pending recommendation of the Washington Township Planning Board, having met the conditions and requirements of the Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance, and having received approval from the Township Engineer,

Zoning Officer and the Sewage Enforcement Officer, consider a motion to approve a lot split of 12.0316 acres, being a part of the parcel of land identified as Tax ID #24-01-120, conveyed from Daniel Bailey to Scott Bailey & Alisha Hall, husband and wife.

2. Approval of Correction to Lot Split Acreage– Minor to Schaefer

Recommended Action

Consider a motion to correct the acreage from 9.914 to 11.002 to the Lot Split conveyed by William R. and Denise Minor to Kameron and Lauren Schaefer, being a part of the parcel of land identified as Tax ID #24-03-121E. Said Lot Split was recommended for approval by the Washington Township Planning Board on May 5, 2022 and was subsequently given final approval by the Washington Township Supervisors at a meeting held on May 10, 2022.
