Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, March 12, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Harry D. Gillispie, Chairman, Daniel R. Stoneking, Vice Chairman, Paul Cook, Supervisor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Dave Brendel was the only visitor present.

Paul made a motion to approve the minutes of the February meeting as read. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Harry asked Mr. Brendel when the traps would be placed for the spotted lantern flies. He stated that the master gardener's club is waiting for instructions from the Penn State Extension office.

The bids for the Grinnage Run Road bridge replacement project were opened and read at noon. Eight bids were received as follows:

Paul made a motion to award the contract to Slusarczyk Excavating, LLC as the lowest bidder. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously. Harry thanked Iron Senergy for purchasing the bridge in the amount of \$59,124.42.

Clean Up Days will be held on April 18<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 to 4:00, April 19<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 to 4:00 and on April 20<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 to 2:00.

In old business the improvements to the exterior of the office building were not advertised for bid yet.

The code enforcement report was reviewed. Citations for road weight violations are still being made and fines collected. No engineering report was given.

Paul made a motion to advertise for bids for #8 washed "slag" aggregate and #8 unwashed aggregate. Bids will be opened noon on April 9<sup>th</sup> and the contract(s) will be awarded at the April 9<sup>th</sup> meeting. Paul stated that the slag aggregates are PennDOT approved. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2-2024 for the DCNR grant application for the proposed new concession stand project at the park. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

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A motion was made by Dan to renew the franchise agreement with Comcast. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dan to advertise 2 blades to be sold at Behm's consignment auction on March 30<sup>th</sup>. Paul seconded and the motion was made unanimously.

Paul made a motion to advertise for bids for the improvements to the exterior of the office to be opened and read at noon on April 9<sup>th</sup>. If there is an acceptable bid, the contract will be awarded at the meeting at 5:00 on April 9<sup>th</sup>. A mandatory walk through will be held on April 1<sup>st</sup> at 10:00 a.m. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Dan and the meeting was adjourned at 5:09 p.m.
