The Greene County Prison Board meeting was brought to order by Commissioner Mike Belding at 11:45 am in the first-floor meeting room of the County office building. Others in attendance were: Commissioner Betsy McClure, Commissioner Blair Zimmerman, Warden Kingston, Carol Gooden, District Attorney Davie Russo, Ami Cree, Steve Barrett, Gene Grimm, Sarah Penich, and Keith McClure.

MOTIONS

1 Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the minutes from January 30 2020. Vote unanimous.

SECURITY

1. There was one (1) reportable Extraordinary Occurrence Reports (EOR) submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections for the Month of January 2020.
2. The facility issued eleven (11) major misconducts and twenty-nine (29) minor misconducts for the month of January 2020.

TREATMENT

1. For January we conducted seven (7) Adult Education classes, four (4) Bible Study classes from Landmark Baptist Church, four (4) Domestic Violence groups, four (4) Celebrate Recovery groups, three (3) Axiom family sessions, and one (1) Narcotics Anonymous group.

STAFFING AND TRAINING

1. Interviews were conducted on 021320 for currently open positions in regards to female Corrections Officer. We currently have a

full time and a part time position available. Two (2) candidates were selected and submitted to be hired in a casual status for evaluation and assessment.

2. Lieutenant John Fox has returned to his former position as Director of Drug and Alcohol in Human Services. John's tenure at the GCP has greatly benefited our organization by his demonstrated leadership and his can-do attitude.

MAINTENANCE

1. The Men's work crew is assisting County Maintenance with projects at the Airport and continues support work for the Redevelopment Authority.

FINANCIAL REPORT

1. Fayette County has paid \$3,600.00 for January, and currently owes \$950.00 for February 2020.

2. Deposits totaling \$2,280.00 have been made with the Treasurer's Office for January with \$800.00 for work release and \$1,480.00 for weekend fees.

3. The January assessed revenue report generated from the Greene County Central Booking Center was \$6,475.00 with a collected total of \$1,876.84 paid to the Clerk of Courts Office.
