c. <u>Renewal of Package Insurance Policy – 2022-23</u>

Last year the premium for the township's Property, Inland Marine, Liability, Public Official's Liability, Excess Liability (Umbrella), Automobile and Crime insurance coverage was \$14,321.00.

Recommended Action

Consider a motion to approve the renewal of the Package Insurance Policy with Higbee Insurance based on the requested and updated coverage, at the annual premium of \$15,157, an increase of \$836, with an effective date of August 8, 2022. The change is due to increased values on owned equipment and an automatic 4% increase in property values. d. <u>2022-23 Impact Fund Spending Plan</u>

As announced at the July meeting, the township received \$778,638.37 from the PA Act 13 Impact Fee fund. As required, attached is the township's spending plan for the funds.

Pursuant to the July 14, 2020 action taken by the Supervisors to contribute \$50,000 to Washington Township's primary fire responder, Waynesburg-Franklin Twp. Volunteer Fire Company toward the purchase of a new fire engine and equipment, consider a motion to make the final of three payments of \$16,670 from the Impact Fee Fund.
