Approve Minutes from April 11, 2024 Recessed Meeting

- **Primary Election Update - Joseph Lemley**
 - **19,476** Respective Voters/ **8200** total Democrats / **11,276** total Republicans
 - **6,728** ballots cast – **5,164** at the polls – **1,558** mail – **6** provisional
 - **34.55%** voter turnout
 - All 42 precincts responded and the respective Poll Location Boards returned their materials accordingly. The election office would like to thank each and every poll worker, around the clock canvassers, maintenance and custodial worker, and every county official for the efforts before, especially during, and after this election. A very special thanks to the maintenance staff lead by Jason Bowser for the diligent effort of getting the equipment to the respective locations and returning the same safely and effectively. Another very special thanks to the team of rovers lead by IT Director Doug Murray who traveled about the county to take on the various concerns at each poll location. A final thanks to our Board of Elections/County Commissioners and our Chief Clerk who saw this election through from start to finish late Tuesday night. Their guidance and wisdom have made the job of my office a smooth transition from novice to somewhat more experienced in the matters of Greene County Elections.
