Do you have someplace to go?

The Greene County Transportation
Program transports eligible riders to
and from destinations in and around
the Greene County area. The program
is available to anyone that lives in the
Greene County area.

Greene County Transportation Program is a Shared Ride Program that means you will likely be riding with other consumers and other consumers may be picked up and dropped off before you reach your destination. In most instances, no one rides for more than an hour, but the trip may take longer due to other passengers.

We provide Door-to-Door services for any consumers that request assistance. You may receive assistance between the door of your pick-up and the door of your destination. Drivers are not permitted to enter your residence to assist for any reason.

There are a number of ways to qualify for the Greene County Transportation Program. Inside are brief descriptions of each of the programs under which an individual may be eligible.

Funding for the Greene County Transportation Program is provided by the PA Department of Aging, the PA Department of Human Services, the Shared Ride Program of the PA Department of Transportation and the Greene County Board of Commissioners.

AVAILABLE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS

Senior Shared Ride

- For ages 65 years of age or older
- · Medical appointments
- Free rides to Senior centers
- Shopping



Medical Assistance Transportation Program (MATP)

- For county residents who have medical assistance (Access Card)
- Must meet specific requirements
- Medical trips covered include: therapies, dental visits, pharmacy and medical equipment suppliers
- Mileage reimbursement program available for residents with their own vehicle

Persons with Disabilities (PWD)

- For ages 18-64
- Must have a qualifying disability (physical or mental)
- Must provide proof of your disability from a physician or agency
