**THE WARRIOR TRAIL**

**A HIKING TRAIL**

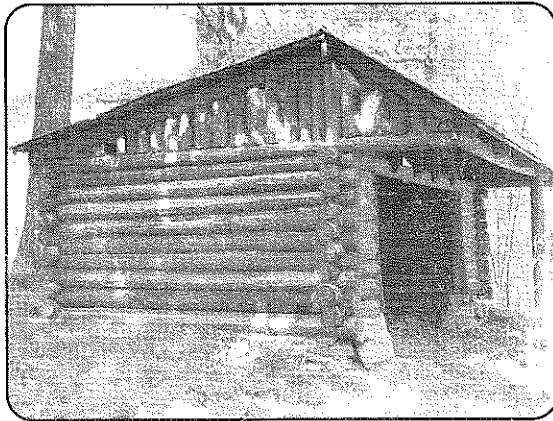
The volunteers of the Warrior Trail Association of Greene County, Pennsylvania maintain this path used for 5,000 years by the Native Americans from the east going to Flint Ridge, Ohio to obtain supplies of flint and conduct commerce.

From the eastern terminus at Milepost O on the Monongahela River the trail is generally east-west about 5 to 6 miles north of the Mason Dixon line, passing over I-79 near the new Kirby Welcome Center. It extends 45 miles westward across Greene County to the border with Marshall County, West Virginia. The trail follows the divide between watersheds. There are no streams to ford. It is blazed with yellow dots on posts and trees along the trail and on both sides of any road crossing. It can easily be located and entered at any one of these crossings. When the trail turns, the blaze is a large dot with a small one on the side toward the turn.

The HIKERS GUIDE contains narrative directions and detailed topographical maps showing the location of the mileposts, the road crossings, and the three Adirondack shelters. There are numbers on the maps referring to the detailed descriptions of the scenery, vegetation, historical sites, and geology, also in the Guide.

Hikers on the trail should be respectful of private property. Please use care not to damage fences and do not open livestock gates. Please do not deposit any trash or litter. We have no means to reserve shelters - they are on a first come, first served basis.

Please relay your comments upon completion of your hike.



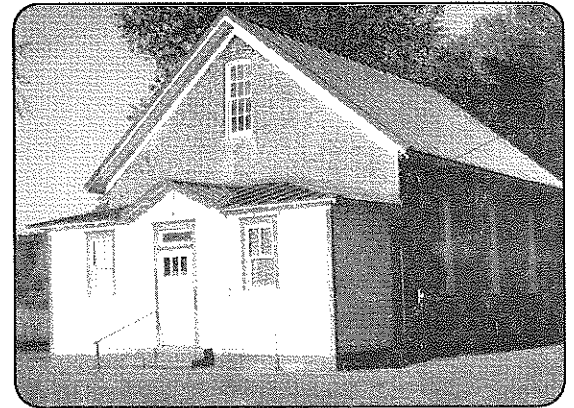
*Moninger Shelter
