

The Washington Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, September 12, 2011 at 10 am in the township building with Chairman Bryant Dean presiding. Other board members present were Jason Rosa, Leonard Dulaney and Becky McCullough, secretary. Others present are listed in the minute attachment book. A motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting was made by Jason Rosa, seconded by Leonard Dulaney. Motion carried. The treasurer's report was given and a motion to accept the report was made by Jason Rosa, seconded by Leonard Dulaney. Motion carried.

No correspondence, ordinances or resolutions, and committee reports.

Old business - A motion was made by Jason Rosa to release the bond for CNX on Pettit, Breakneck and Pisgah Ridge Roads. The motion was seconded by Leonard Dulaney. Motion carried.

New business - A motion to trade in W-3 and the grader to purchase a new truck was made by Jason Rosa seconded by Bryant Dean. Leonard Dulaney opposed. A question was asked why we are buying a new truck in this economy. Bryant replied that W-3 has been in the shop several times and it cannot be fixed and it is unsafe to drive. We will be purchasing with piggyback and using approximately \$50,000 out of the Machinery Fund. A motion to have Suit-Kote pave the walking trail at the park was made by Jason, seconded by Bryant. Motion carried. Three companies were contacted, Ten Mile with no response, Brandt looked at it and said they could not do it; Suit-Kote gave an estimate of \$8200.00. Jason Rosa motioned to pay the bills, Leonard Dulaney seconded. Motion carried.

Public comment - Rita Martin asked why the potholes were not filled before the township tarred and chipped. Bryant stated he did not know what she was talking about. Rita asked who sent Mr. George to her neighbor's home on a sewage complaint. Bryant stated no one from this office sent Mr. George out.

No further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 10:10 am.
