

## FARM STOCK TRACTOR PULLS

Driver must remain in seat at all times

Must be stock appearing

No riders. **NO ENTRY REFUNDS!**

The rules are as follow:

1. No alcoholic beverages on fairgrounds. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Any participants will be disqualified from pull if believed to be a safety hazard and will be barred with **NO REFUND** of entry fee.
2. The starting pull will be made from a tight chain with no jerking.
3. All contestants may be subject to re-weigh.
4. **ONLY** the driver will be permitted on a vehicle when it is being towed or driven, **NO RIDERS.** No rider in or on any vehicle in pit or track this includes tow tractors, competing vehicles, tow back and maintenance equipment of any kind. When the pulling vehicle's motor is running, the driver must be in the seat. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
5. **NO ONE IS PERMITTED ON THE TRACK EXCEPT FOR THE TRACK OFFICIALS AND CONTESTANTS.** Track is defined as the area within 25 feet in any direction of the contest course boundaries, including the run-off area at the finish end of the track.
6. Official will tell driver/contestant when to start a pull.
7. Contest open to 2 wheel drive tractors with rubber tires. No sharpened tires, cut tires, dual tires, tires studs or chains permitted.
8. All weight frames and weights must be stationary and safely secured to the tractor. If weights fall off it is an automatic disqualification.
9. **NO ATPA or NTPA tractors permitted.**
10. All tractors must have wheel brakes in working condition.
11. No drivers under 14 years of age. Any driver up to 18 years of age must have written consent from parent or guardian and be present.
12. All safety rules added by P.T.P.A and/or insurance carriers will be enforced
13. **ALL DECISIONS MADE BY TRACK JUDGE OR SUPERINTENDENT AND OFFICIALS ARE FINAL!!!!!!!**
14. A speed limit or pace tractor may be used.
15. If clevis is used, it must have a bolt and nut.

16. Drawbar to be stationary in all directions with no more than 1" movement in any one direction. Maximum height of drawbar for 5500# and 7500# classes will be 18". Maximum height of drawbar for 9500#, 12000#, 14000# and 16000# will be 20". Length of drawbar to be no less than 18" from center of rear axle. Drawbar must be equipped with a steel opening. Cross-sectioned thickness must be 7/8 minimum. Pulling point may not be more than 1 1/2" from back edge of hitching device. No top link bracing of drawbar. No top link bracing except complete factory set-up. No quick hitch type. Hole must be at least 3" wide and 3 1/2" long to accept sled hook.
17. 3000 RPM limit, random check, puller of class must be the one to rpm tractor. All tractors must have a visible throttle stop.
18. Cut tires and radials are permitted.
19. Tractors may enter in two classes only.
20. Anyone not abiding by above rules or creating a disturbance --- shall be subject to disqualification and ejection of the grounds. NO REFUNDS!!!
21. All participants entering track must pay at the gate.
