Rules and Regulations:

1. The sheep must be fitted for show and trained to lead with a halter. It must be a good representation of the breed. Decorations on the sheep are permitted. At no time should the contestant handle the sheep while in the show arena. A yearling ewe or ewe lamb is required for the Ladies Lead Line. Shepherds must have a yearling ram, ram lamb or wether lamb.
2. Outfits worn by the contestants must be made of 100% wool or a wool blend with a minimum of 60% wool.
3. Each contestant must provide a short personal commentary. It is to be written in the third person (she, he, etc.). Please limit to one minute.
4. Contestants should be ready 20 minutes before the start of the contest.
5. The overall appearance of the contestant and animal will be rated by a panel of 3 judges.
6. There is no room for lead class sheep to be housed at the fairgrounds.
7. Coordinator reserves the right to place in this class.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Any girl age 16-20 by June 1, 2017 and a resident of Greene County may enter.
2. All participants must write an essay (typewritten, 300 words or less) on "What the Greene County Fair Means to My Community."
3. All participants must give a speech (3 to 5 minutes) on "Why You Should Come to the Greene County Fair." (Creativity is encouraged) The use of props is permitted.
4. No names are to appear on the essays. Please enclose a separate sheet with your name, address, telephone number, parents names, age, hobbies and activities, grade just completed, and the high school or college you are attending.
5. All essays will be judged on neatness, grammar and originality.
6. Contestants will be judged on poise, appearance (must be attired in a gown), neatness and ability to communicate.
7. Deadline for all entries is June 30.
8. Send all entries to Fair Queen Contest c/o Greene County Fair PO Box 806, Waynesburg, PA 15370
9. Speeches will be given on Sunday August 6, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. at the Greene County Fairgrounds.
10. The winner will have the opportunity to compete in the Pennsylvania State Fair Queen Contest which will be held in January 2018 in Hershey, Pennsylvania.
11. The queen must be single, never married, have had no children and must not marry, or become pregnant during her reign.
12. The queen must be able to appear at various functions, parades etc., and sign contract.
13. If there are not 2 participants in this competition it will be cancelled.
14. Act in accordance with the PA Fair Queen behavior policy.
15. Meet all commitments, Queen obligations and dress code set forth by Greene County Fair Board and follow **all rules** set forth by the board.
