1. All cattle exhibited for competition must be registered or eligible for registry.
2. Purity of blood as established by pedigree, symmetry, size, early maturity and general characteristics of the several breeds of animals to be considered; the judges will make proper allowance for age, feeding and other conditions.

- 3. Entry fee: \$3.00 entry per class, per animal. No refund. Fee must accompany entry.**
4. No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.
5. Individual animals shown in all of the group and herd classes listed below must have entered and shown in one of the following classes for single animals.
6. All animals must be registered as the property of the exhibitor.
7. No bedding will be provided.
8. All animals will be checked in on Sunday, August 7, 8:30 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.
9. All trimming shutes must be kept in designated areas. No trimming shutes in alleyways, display area or tack areas.

11. A penalty of \$25.00 per animal will be assessed to the owner/exhibitor of any beef animal entered and not exhibited at the fair. Entries cancelled on or before Friday, August 5, 2011, will permit a refund of fees with no penalty. Entry cancellations received after the penalty applies.
