DEPARTMENT VI – OPEN DAIRY GOATS

SECTION 1

Show - 9:00 a.m, Monday, August 8th

Entry Fee: \$1.50 per class, per animal

1. Animals must be in place by 3:00 p.m., Sunday, August 7th.
2. Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration certificate/stamped duplicate. Proof of ownership must be presented to the chairperson no later than two hours prior to the show.
3. Base date of computing animals age is August 1, 2011.
4. All goats must have an official ear tag or legible breed registration tattoo.
5. No goat showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to the show.
6. All animals must be tested for brucellosis if over six months of age, and for tuberculosis regardless of age.

7. An accredited veterinarian shall sign the statement of health on the AAI-11 test report that the animal(s) were examined within 30 days of issuance of the health certificate. All animals must be accompanied by an official health certificate.

8. ALL GOATS MUST HAVE AN OFFICIAL EARTAG OR LEGIBLE BREED REGISTRATION TATTOO.

9. ALL GOATS EXCEPT WETHERS MUST BEAR AN OFFICIAL U.S.D.A./A.P.H.I.S EARTAG TO BE EXHIBITED AT THE SHOW. THE ONLY EXCEPTIONS ARE THOSE GOATS THAT HAVE A REGISTRATION TATTOO AND HAVE BEEN CODED WITH A PREMISE I.D. NUMBER.

No goat showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease including caseous lymphadenitis, sore mouth, active erring worm, foot rot, warts, lice and mange will be admitted to the show.

Health Certificate – An accredited veterinarian shall sign the statement of health on the AAI-11 test report that he examined the animal(s) within 30 days of issuance of the health certificate. All animals must be accompanied by an official health certificate.

Tuberculosis test - Not required.

No test required for Brucellosis.

All animals must be individually identified on the health certificate.

DEPARTMENT X – 4-H AND VOCATIONAL/FFA

This department is open to Greene County 4-H and FFA members only.

4-H age is determined by January 1 of the current year. Members must be between the ages of 8 and 18. Classes based on age will use 4-H age.

*All 4H/FFA project books must be completed and turned into the extension office by June 1 of this current year. **Failure to do so makes entry null and void.**

The J. Gross Dinsmore Family will give a shepherd's staff or a showmans cane in his memory in a 4H animal department of their choice.

All entries close June 30. Must be Post Marked!

Junior & Youth Division classes eligibility. These classes are open to 4-H Club members and Vocational Agriculture students. Exhibitors must have passed their 8th birthday but not have passed their 11th birthday by January 1, 2011. Exhibitors must be members of a regularly organized 4-H Club or be Vocational Agriculture Students, carrying a project in the field they wish to make entry and be under the supervision of the Pennsylvania State University Agricultural and Cooperative Extension Service or Vocational Agriculture Instructor.

GREENE COUNTY 4-H HORSE AND PONY SHOW

All 4-H horses and ponies must have a rabies vaccination and Coggins Certificate.
