2. Entrant's outfit must be made of at least **60 percent wool** (fiber content). Contestants need not make outfit.

3. Female contestants must use yearling ewes or ewe lambs. Male contestants must use yearling rams, ram lambs or wether lambs. 4-H and FFA market lambs are not encouraged, but substitute lambs are permitted.

4. The sheep must be conditioned, fitted and trained to show at halter. The contestant should not handle the sheep with their hands in the show ring. Coordinating decoration on sheep is permitted.

5. A separate commentary (which must include the name, full mailing address, parents' names, age of the entrant, a description of the outfit to be worn, activities of the entrant and the age, breed, and owner of the sheep to be used) should be sent to:

All commentaries must be in by August 2nd.

All commentaries should be typed and in the third person (he/she).

6. All contestants must be at the arena ready to begin the contest 15 minutes prior to the start of the contest.

No one is permitted on track except track official and contestants.

STOCK CLASSES

1. Judges decisions are FINAL! Any disagreements will end in disqualification.
2. Kill switch must be near center above hitch.
3. All tractors must have roll protection. Wheels or skid plates must be no more than 5 inches high and no more than 5 inches from rear of tire.
4. All hitches must be in plain view. Must be easy to hook and unhook.
5. 12 inch hitch. Must have 1 1/2 hole. Hook must swing in hitch. All adjustment all thread must be taped behind hitch hole. All thread must have fixed nuts on top and bottom so hitch cannot move up or down.
6. All tractors must have stock appearing hood, grill, and fenders. Wheel base no longer than 54 inches.
7. Side shield on both sides covering engine and flywheel. 1/16 steel, 3/16 aluminum. Must cover all moving parts, belts, pulleys, crankshaft and clutch.

8. No all thread sticking out on rear wheels.
9. Must have a back on seat.
10. What can be done to all FLAT HEAD ENGINES: 30-thousandths overbore, 3 angle valve job, port and polish outside of valves and shave head.
11. All OVERHEAD VALVES 20 HP TWINS: must be 100% stock. The way it came from the factory is the way is better stay.
12. All engines must have and meet factory specs. No cam grinding, working governor, carb that comes with engine, choke plate, stock timing, stock piston, rings, rods, crank, valves and flywheel with fins. Proper tin work and serial numbers.
13. Tech officials have the right to disqualify any person driving in an unsafe manner. No fish tailing.
14. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES during the pulls. This is for the safety of all.
15. Weight booms no longer than 6 feet from center of rear wheel.
16. Anybody walking with kids must be a safe distance from the tractor.
17. Only 2 hooks per tractor. Exceptions are: Powder Puff or parent driving kid's tractor.
18. Once the sign up sheet goes to the track, THAT CLASS IS CLOSED.
19. At any time, Ernie or Bob have any reason to think you are cheating, we can and will tear your engine down. If the engine is legal, we will pay for any damaged parts. If the engine is not legal, say your good-byes. You will not be back.

The rules are as follows:

1. No alcoholic beverages on fairgrounds. NO EXCEPTIONS!! Any participant will be disqualified from pull if believed to be a safety hazard and will be barred with no refund of entry fee*
2. The starting pull will be made from a tight chain with no jerking.
3. All contestants may be subject to re-weight and dyno check.
4. ONLY the driver will be permitted on a vehicle when it is being towed or driven, NO RIDERS. No rider in or on any vehicle, in pit, or track this includes tow tractors, competing vehicles, tow back and maintenance equipment of any kind. When the pulling vehicle's motor is running the driver must be in the seat. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
5. NO ONE IS PERMITTED ON THE TRACK EXCEPT FOR THE TRACK OFFICIALS AND CONTESTANTS. (Exception will be driver under the age of 18- one person is permitted with tractor and driver.) Track is defined as the area within 25 feet in any direction of the contest course boundaries, including the run-off area at the finish end of the track.
6. The contestant will be given one try to pull the load.
7. Official will tell driver/contestant when to start a pull.
8. Tractor must be stock block agricultural tractor with no visual engine modifications. No cubic inch limit. Engine must be of original type of factory replacement. Original style hood and grille must be in place.
9. Contest open to 2 wheel drive tractors with rubber tires. No sharpened tires, cut tires, dual tires, tire studs or chains permitted.
10. All weight frames and weights must be stationary and safety secured to the tractor.
11. The use of torque converters, automatic shifts, etc, will be permitted. No slipper clutches.
12. 5500#, 7500#, and 9500# Classes-No turbo chargers or inter coolers allowed unless factory equipped. 12000#, 14000#, 16000# Classes-Turbo chargers and inter coolers are allowed. Any add on turbo chargers or inter coolers must be factory type and pass track judge's inspection.
13. NO ATPA OR NTPA tractors permitted.
14. All tractors must have wheel brakes in working condition.
15. All Stock Tractors are limited to a maximum 2500 RPM or unless factory rating is higher. If during a check of RPM's the tractor exceeds 2500 RPM's the tractor will be barred from pulling at that event and all purse monies if any have been accumulated by that tractor at that event, are forfeited back to the fair. If a driver is notified after making a pull but before leaving the track area of an RPM check and an average of 3 consecutive checks shows RPM's in excess of 2500 RPM's then the tractor is disqualified.
16. No electronic governor or rev limiters. During pull, governor must be in working condition and must not allow engine to exceed 2500 RPM under load.
17. Any rotating power take-off, if unable to be stopped by the driver, must be shielded.
18. No drivers under 14 years of age. Any driver up to 18 years of age must have written consent from parent or guardian and be present.
19. Rim width no wider than the tire size.
20. All safety rules added by P.T.P.A. and/or insurance carriers will be enforced.
21. ALL DECISIONS BY TRACK JUDGE OR SUPERINTENDENT AND OFFICIALS ARE FINAL!!!!
22. A speed limit or pace tractor may be used.
23. If clevis is used, it must have a bolt and nut.
24. Factory equipped drawbar to be stationary in all directions with no more than 1" movement in any one direction. Maximum height of drawbar for 5500#, 7500# classes will be 18". Maximum height of drawbar for 9500#, 12000#, 14000#, 16000# classes will be 20". Length of drawbar to be no less than 18" from center of rear axle. Drawbar must be equipped with a steel opening. Cross-sectioned thickness must be 7/8 minimum. Pulling point may not be more than 1 1/2" from back edge of hitching device. No top link bracing of drawbar. No top link bracing except complete factory set-up. No quick hitch type.
25. Cut tires allowed in Open Stock.
26. Tractors may enter in two classes only.
27. Tractors must pull in Stock Class or Open Stock. No crossing between Stock and Open Stock.
28. Stock Class: Horns up to 100 feet unlimited, after 100 feet, you get a horn you are disqualified.
29. Both classed, no water, alcohol or any other kind of oxygen accelerant.
30. Anyone not abiding by above rules or creating a disturbance—shall be subject to disqualification and ejection of the grounds. NO REFUNDS!!!
