

## Greene County Fair Events

WAYNESBURG — Participants sought for contests at the Greene County Fair.

Greene County Sheep and Wool Growers Association is seeking contestants interested in earning the title *Greene County Lamb and Wool Queen*. The contest will be held August 8 during the Greene County Fair.

To compete, contestants must be at least 16 years old, own sheep or be from an active sheep-producing farm and have carried a 4-H or FFA sheep project this year. The queen is encouraged to enter the state competition held in October, and is expected to participate in any event in Greene County relating to lamb and wool.

*Leadline Contest* set for August 8.

In another lamb-related competition, the *Ladies' and Shepherds' Leadline Contest* will be held at 7 p.m. August 8 in the livestock arena.

The purpose of this event is to promote the sheep and wool industry by presenting sheep in an attractive manner and allowing spectators an opportunity to see the best of the industry.

Age categories will be Tiny Tots, ages 3-7; Juniors, 8-13 and Seniors, 14-19. Contestants must wear garments that contain at least 60 percent wool. The clothing does not necessarily have to be made by the contestant or their family.

Girls will lead a ewe lamb, or yearling ewe, and boys will lead a ram lamb, yearling ram, or weather. Contestants are encouraged not to use a project lamb. Sheep should be conditioned, fitted, and trained to show at halter, and decoration on the sheep is permitted.

Commentaries need to include name, mailing address, parents name and phone number, age of entrant, description of outfit, activities of the entrant, and the sheep's age, breed, and owner.
