

## GREENE COUNTY FAIR QUEEN CROWNED

WAYNESBURG — Chelsea Wilson, 17, daughter of Amy and Doug Wilson of Waynesburg, was crowned the 2013 Miss Greene County Fair Queen, Saturday at the Greene County Fairgrounds.

Wilson, who will be a senior at Jefferson-Morgan Junior-Senior High School, was to compete against Sadie Wright of Mt. Morris, but Wright withdrew from the competition prior to Saturday's judging.

Nonetheless, the National Honor Society student continued the process as though she had competition for the crown.

She had a personal interview with the judges; answered impromptu questions; gave a brief speech on *"What My Fair Means to My Community;"* was judged on a written essay based on reasons for wanting to be the fair queen, and modeled an evening gown.

Chelsea was crowned by Christa Ziefel, the 2012 Greene County Fair Queen. Wilson now becomes eligible to compete for the state fair queen title early next year.
