

Franklin Township supers create board

WAYNESBURG - Franklin Township supervisors voted Monday to create a three-member board to hear appeals regarding enforcement of the Uniform Construction Code.

The code, which took effect in 2004, requires all new construction to conform to a single state-designated building code. Builders must have certified inspectors review building plans and conduct inspections on various aspects of construction.

The new board will hear appeals regarding enforcement of the code. In addition to creating the board, the supervisors appointed its three members. They are J.T. Rafail, Randy Ashcroft and Craig Maley.
