Steven Lee Phillips

A Greene County native, Steve's interests ranged from kickboxing to candles. When not working as a design engineer for International Paper, he could be found building or modifying his computer system, playing paintball, practicing at the pistol range, cooking steaks for neighbors and friends, shooting pool or delving into the latest sci-fi fantasy novel. Steven was most noted for his warm smile, off the wall one liners and a metallic green camaro (his baby). During his time with the Marines, Steve trained as a weapons specialist earning the title "assaultman". He shot a SMAW (shoulder mount assault weapon) and became an expert with explosives. After completing two tours in Afghanistan, Lance Cpl. Phillips was six months into a seven month tour in Iraq when he became a fatality of a HUMVEE accident in AL ANBAR PROVINCE as his squad was responding to a report of suspicious activity.

US Army Specialist Gregory Cox

Greg was the first Greene County Serviceman to die in the fighting in Iraq. Specialist Gregory A. Cox, 21, of Carmichaels, died Monday, September 27, 2004, as the result of injuries when the Humvee he was driving overturned near Balad, Iraq. He was born July 6, 1983 in Pittsburgh, a son of John E. and Mary Anne Cox of Carmichaels. Gregory was a member and an altar server at the All Saints Roman Catholic Church in Masontown. He graduated from All Saints School of Masontown and was a 2001 graduate of Geibel Catholic High School. Specialist Cox was inducted into the U.S. Army on August 29, 2001, completing his basic training and armor training at Fort Knox, Kentucky and was then stationed with the 1st Armored Division at Schweinfert, Germany. He served a six month tour of duty in Kosovo and had been in Iraq for seven months at the time of his death. Greg loved animals and enjoyed the outdoors.
