Dock to Lock 5K Run winners announced

MILLSBORO, PA. – The Greene County Department of Recreation recently announced the winners of the 2019 Dock to Lock 5K Run/Walk, which was held on May 11 at the Greene River Trail.

The race began at the trail starting point at the Greene Cove Yacht Club in Millsboro. An awards ceremony at the Rices Landing Fire Hall followed the race. Prizes were given for the top three male and female runners and walkers overall, as well as the top three male and female runners and walkers in various age categories.

The top three overall winners in the 5K run were:

- Male: First place, Eslie Sykes, 58, of Lawrence, 21:08; second place, Vincent Cirota, 46, of Clarksville, 22:42; and third place, Darin Acklin, 36, of Rices Landing, 22:48.
- Female: First place, Kelly Kiger, 41, of Waynesburg, 26:00; second place, Donna Leretsis, 34, of Carmichaels, 26:28; and third place, Lori Kubincanek, 53 of Fredericktown, 26:38.

The top three overall winners in the 5K walk were:

- Male: First place, Richard Respole, 67, of Bellaire, Ohio, 39:35; second place, Dennis Cropp, 66 of Uniontown, 39:36; and third place, Ken Fortunato, 50, of Carmichaels, Pa 41:26.
- Female: First place, Jane Naymick, 64, of Uniontown 40:09; second place, Linda Keller, 66, of Waynesburg, 41:09; and third place, Dania Fortunato, 49, of Carmichaels, 41:25.

The age categories awarded for runners were: 14 and under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-69 and 70-plus. For walkers, the age categories awarded were: 19 and under, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69 and 70-plus.

A random drawing for prizes was also held following the race. The following participants present at the awards ceremony won \$25 Wal-Mart gift cards: Lori Kubincanek of Fredericktown, Emily Krocsko of Fredericktown, Rachel Jones of Hollbrook and Kathy Cipcic of Mather.
