

**COMMISSIONERS MEETING
MARCH 8, 2018**

The Greene County Commissioners meeting was brought to order at 10:00 am by Chairman Blair Zimmerman in the first floor meeting room of the county office building. Others in attendance were: Commissioner Coder, Commissioner Trader, Chief Clerk Jeff Marshall, Cheryl Cowen, Joanne Marshall, Carol Gooden, Charlotte Popielarcheck and the General Public.

Calvin Cox, Commander and Bob Martin, Chaplain, to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES— Commissioner Trader made the motion and Commissioner Coder the second to approve the minutes from February 22, 2018. Vote unanimous.

FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

1. Commissioner Coder made the motion and Commissioner Trader the second to approve change order #1 from Morgan Excavating, LP in the amount of \$70,820.00 for the Greene County Airport Access Road East and Parking Lot. Vote unanimous.
2. Commissioner Trader made the motion and Commissioner Coder the second for a grant request from the Waynesburg American Legion James Farrell Post 330 in an amount up to \$3600.00 for updates payable upon receipt. Vote unanimous.
3. Commissioner Coder made the motion and Commissioner Trader the second for a right-of-way and acquisition services from ARROW for Greene County Bridge #8 (located in Perry Township) in the amount of \$16,531.22. Vote unanimous.
4. Commissioner Trader made the motion and Commissioner Coder the second to approve a lease between the County of Greene and Jason Neighbors in the amount of \$300.00 for a parking lot on the south side of Waynesburg pending Solicitor approval. Vote unanimous.
5. Commissioner Coder made the motion and Commissioner Trader the second for a request from the Brighter Greene Coalition for \$16,000 to support the botvin curriculum administered in all five school districts. Vote unanimous.
6. Commissioner Trader made the motion and Commissioner Coder the second to appoint Renee Miclnicki, Esquire General Counsel/Employment Law Consultant; Renee Donofrio, Human Resources Coordinator Blue Prints and Brian Perkins, Controller/Human Resources Manager East Coast Risk Management to the Administrative Review Panel for the Greene County Merit Hire System. Vote unanimous.
7. Commissioner Coder made the motion and Commissioner Trader the second to approve a request from EQT to utilize an existing driveway off of Progress Drive for a natural gas pipeline project pending Solicitor approval. Vote unanimous.
8. Commissioner Coder made the motion and Commissioner Trader the second to appoint members to the Greene County Comprehensive Plan Project Advisory Committee. Vote unanimous.
9. Commissioner Trader made the motion and Commissioner Coder the second to waive all the back taxes, penalties and interest on tax map parcel #21-05-110. Property is listed as exempt on current tax assessment records. Vote unanimous.

1. Commissioner Trader made the motion and Commissioner Coder the second for a contract for Professional Services between the County of Greene and Mission Critical Partners, LLC to provide Radio System Console and Interoperability Assessment. Vote unanimous.
