2. CONSOL Pennsylvania Coal Company, LLC is submitting a permit application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for the installation of three degas boreholes for the Bailey Mine located in Richhill Township.

A copy of this plan, including an inundation map noting areas in Richhill Township at the following locations Ryerson Station State Park, Richhill Township EMA, Greene County Emergency and Marshall County EMA.
12. The Department of Environmental Protection has made a modification to the registration of general permit #WMGR123SW010 for operation of the Greene County Water Treatment Facility located in Franklin Township.
13. James McClure, Jr. is applying to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for a (GP-5) utility line stream crossing coverage and will be installing a 1" gas line to the business in Aleppo Township.
