**MINUTES**— Commissioner Trader made the motion and Commissioner Coder the second to approve the minutes from May 18, 2017. Vote unanimous.

**RELOLUTIONS**

1. Commissioner Coder made the motion and Commissioner Trader the second for a resolution for Regional Transportation Alliance's Seven Principles. Vote unanimous.
