



Class 13.....Angel Food Cake Contest Rules
Premiums \$25.00 \$15.00 \$10.00

Rules and Regulations:

1. Open to any individual who is a Pennsylvania resident.
2. **Entrants may NOT have won 1st place in this Angel Food Cake contest at any other fair in 2018.**
3. Entry must be an Angel Food Cake made from "scratch".
4. Pennsylvania produced & packaged eggs are requested to be used if at all possible. Please look for the PEQAP or PA Preferred logo or PA packaging dates on the carton.
5. The entire cake entry must be submitted for judging on cardboard. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)
6. Recipe(s) listing the ingredients and the preparation instructions must be submitted with th entry. It should be submitted on one side of 8 1/2"x11" paper. The recipe must list all the ingredients, quantities and the preparation instructions. Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back side of all the pages. (All recipes and pies will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will not be returned.)
7. Refrigeration is not available at the Fair or PA Farm Show Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.
8. **Judging Criteria:**

Flavor (<i>smell, taste, flavoring</i>)	30 points
Inside Characteristics (<i>texture & lightness</i>)	25 points
Overall Appearance (<i>surface, size, color</i>)	20 points
Creativity	15 points
Topping, Icing or Decoration	10 points
TOTAL	100 points

- All entries must be pre-registered and brought into the Home & Garden Department on Sunday, August 5, 2018 between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
- The first place winner will be required to enter the 2019 Pennsylvania Farm Show competition. If unable to do so, the 2nd place winner will be eligible to go. Premiums for the PA Farm Show competition (*First - \$500.00; Second - \$250.00; Third - \$100.00; Fourth - Rosette; Fifth - Rosette*).
