Special Meeting Minutes

February 9, 2021

Call to order at 2:30 pm. by Chairman Frank Basile followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Ronnie Howard and Mickey Lemley with secretary Chris Jarrell and Solicitor Dennis Makel.

Public in Attendance: Greg Szallar, Alex Szallar and Howard Goldstein (BFS)

New Business: BFS in attendance to request approval of Liquor License transfer into Perry Township for their new Mt. Morris location. Discussion followed: Greg Szallar, Solicitor with Flaherty & O'Hara representing BFS Companies reported that BFS has been in Mt. Morris over 20 years. BFS has 22 stores in Western PA with 5 serving beer and wine. The Subway Restaurant will have space for seating for 30. All employees will be PLCB trained. The liquor license will transfer from Franklin Township. A motion was made by Mickey Lemley seconded by Ron Howard to approve the liquor license. The Supervisors welcomed BFS and expressed the Community anticipation of this new store.
