A motion is needed to adopt and advertise the proposed Budget for 2022 with estimated revenues of \$1,045,775.00 and expenditures of \$1,045,775.00 for the General Fund and Special Revenue Funds with the final adoption at the December 14, 2021 meeting. Motion by Mickey Lemley seconded by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.

Municipal Benefit Services has presented a new Blue Cross Health Insurance plan (including Dental and Vision) for Perry Township. MBS serves Municipalities so their rates are lower. Quoting a comparable plan to what is in place now, MBS is offering the same/better coverage with a savings of over \$9,700. A motion was made by Ronald Howard seconded by Mickey Lemley to switch to MBS for health insurance including Dental and Vision. Vote: All in favor.
