Minutes – From the Previous Meeting

A motion was made by Ms. Stephenson to accept the minutes of the prior meeting dated June 1, 2020. This motion was seconded by, Mr. Belding. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

A long discussion was had by all members in attendance on how to have a Fair during a pandemic. It was noted that the Fayette County Fair Board was meeting tonight as well. Washington County Fair Board and Jacktown Fair were meeting on Thursday. As of June 1, 2020, our zone for the Pennsylvania State Association of County Fairs has had 10/25 Fairs already cancel.

Mr. Belding reported that a junior livestock sale would occur on Wednesday, August 12, 2020. The Lamb show would occur at 10:00 AM and the Steer show will occur at 2:00 PM. The sale will begin at 6:00 PM. All Buyers have to pre-register.

The Pennsylvania State Fair Queen will be visiting our Fairgrounds on Tuesday, July 21, 2020 at 9:00 AM.

The Fair Queen's reign will be extended by one year due to the pandemic cancelling events that she would have attended.

The members had a discussion on what may need to happen to put on a 2021 Fair as safely as possible. It was agreed that we will need to understand what modifications and changes to procedures and facilities will be necessary if the pandemic is still around next summer.
