

Election Board Meeting

May 31, 2018

The Election Board meeting from May 3, 2018 was reconvened at 9:03 AM on May 31, 2018 by a motion made by Commissioner Archie Trader and seconded by Commissioner Blair Zimmerman, Chairman. Attending the meeting in addition to Commissioners Zimmerman and Trader were Communications Director Steve Barrett, Election Director Tina Kiger, and Administrative Assistant of Elections Amie Nehls.

Old Business:

Director Kiger stated that the voter turnout for the General Primary held May 15, 2018 was a total of 5,404 voters or 27.42% of those registered. She also said there were a few minor machine issues including one machine not clear and tested and two machines that froze. The state certification was signed by the Election Board and would be submitted when the state election system was fixed.

New Business:

Ms. Kiger said she would be arranging some demonstrations of the new voting machines, that will be available for purchase. She would like to have a demonstration for staff and the Election Board and, at a later date, another demonstration for the public. The Election Board was very supportive of this idea, as they had secured funds for new machines three years prior and had started attending vendor demonstrations two years prior.

Director Kiger also stated she would like to combine the four Dunkard Township precincts to two. The voter registration totals support this and two of the precincts will lose their polling places within the next year.
