

ELECTION BOARD MEETING

May 12, 2022

The Greene County Election Board meeting was brought out of recess at 10:56 am by Chairman Mike Belding in the first-floor meeting room of the County Office Building. Others in attendance were: Commissioner Betsy McClure, Commissioner Blair Zimmerman, Chief Clerk Jeff Marshall, Solicitor Robert Grimm, Judy Snyder, and Megan Phillips.

Chairman Mike Belding called to order the recessed October 21, 2021 Election Board meeting. Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second. Vote unanimous.

Old Business: Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the minutes from the October 21, 2021 meeting. Vote unanimous.

New Business:

1. Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the following qualified voters to be appointed to the Canvas Committee for the May 17th Election: Vote unanimous.

2. Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the list provided of

qualified voter to be appointed to serve on the Election Board at the Polls. Vote unanimous.

3. Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve Doug Murray as Custodian to the Electronic Voting System for the May 17, 2022 Primary Election. Vote Unanimous.
4. Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the following Lease Agreement with the County of Greene to conduct all future elections at their facilities, the cost is \$50.00 per election. Effective April 1, 2022. Vote unanimous

5. Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the following locations as temporary polling locations for the 2022 Primary Election. Vote unanimous.
 - a. For Franklin North – The Wellness Center, 350 Bonar Avenue, Waynesburg.
 - b. For Jefferson #3 – Jefferson Volunteer Fire Department, 1483 Jefferson Road, Jefferson.
 - c. For Waynesburg Boro #3 – Wades (Old State Store Building) 653 E. High Street, Waynesburg.
6. Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the Certification of Voter Statistic for the Department of State as well as approving the execution by the Chief Clerk, Jeffrey Marshall. Vote unanimous.
 - a. Number of registered voters in Greene County as of the close of registration is 21,963.
 - b. With a count of 9,136 Democrats and 10,655 Republican being able to participate in the upcoming Primary. The

remaining 2,172 being unable to participate. Effective May 9, 2022.

8. The second Signing of the Official Computation will take place on June 6th at 9A.M., in the Commissioners Meeting Room, first floor of the County Office Building, 93 E. High St., Waynesburg, PA.
