ELECTION BOARD MEETING

June 8, 2022

The Greene County Election Board meeting was brought out of recess at 8:30 am by Chairman Mike Belding in the first-floor meeting room of the County Office Building. Others in attendance were: Commissioner Betsy McClure, Commissioner Blair Zimmerman, Solicitor Robert Grimm and Judy Snyder.

Chairman Mike Belding called to order the recessed June 6, 2022 Election Board meeting.

Old Business: Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the minutes from the June 6, 2022 meeting. Vote unanimous.

New Business:

- 1. When reconciling and verifying the ballot count by Political Party at the polls on election day, it was discovered for the May Primary, that there were 10 Democrats and 1 Independent that was permitted to vote Republican. This specific election code was discussed and stressed at all poll worker classes. Keep in mind that there is no way to identify those voters and their ballot and there is no way to reject their votes and the results must stand. We will continue to stress the importance of verifying the correct ballot selection is made at the polls during Primary Elections.
- Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the Final Certification of Election Returns from the May 17, 2022 Primary, which includes the recount of Republican office for United States Senator. It does not include totals related to the 17 segregated undated ballots. Vote unanimous.
