 - Polling Locations – Remain the same with the exception of Franklin North and Waynesburg Boro 3. Franklin North will again be held at the Wellness Center and Waynesburg Boro 3 will again be held at the Old State Store beside Wades. All registered voters in both polling locations have been mailed a post card notifying them of their polling location.
 - Approval of Appointments of Canvass Board – Participates chosen by the Election Board are still being finalized due to the change in the required process. We will have 3 shifts to pre-canvass and canvass the Absentee and Mail-In ballots. Shifts will be 7:00 am to 3:00 pm; 3:00 pm to 11:00 pm and 11:00 pm to 7:00 am until complete.
