The first three weeks of the course will be the basic principals needed to begin fly tying. Placing the thread on the hook, adding basic body parts of the fly, adding the hackle and tying off the fly.

The second three weeks will be more advanced fly tying with streamers, nymphs and wet flies.

The final three weeks will consist of dry flies, wet flies and copies of insects found in the streams.




