These bags have some traditional Christmas goodies and cards from the Kids of CentrePeace, Inc. out of Bellefonte, PA who make Christmas cards every year for the inmates. The holiday meal will be turkey dinner with all the fixings.

STAFFING AND TRAINING:

1. The Sheriff's Deputies and selected officials are conducting special response team (SRT) training today at the University. There was no scheduled SRT training during the month of November.

MAINTENANCE:

1. The men's work crew has finished some in-house projects which included power washing selected housing units and painting. They have supported the Eastview First Assembly Church with a camera installation project and are currently assisting the Redevelopment Authority.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

- 1. Fayette County has paid \$2,100.00 for October, and is \$3,000.00 for the month of November.
- 2. Deposits totaling \$3,700.00 have been made with the Treasurer's office for November with \$2,340.00 for work release and \$1,360.00 for weekend fees.
- 3. November assessed revenue report generated from the Greene County Central Booking Center was \$7,000.00 with a collected total of \$1,197.00 paid to the clerk of courts office.
