#### Recommended Action

The bids were received and opened at 11:30 am, Thursday, June 8, 2023 for the labor, material, and equipment necessary to complete the paving on Top Road from the SPWA water tank access road to the intersection with Byard Road, and Byard Road between the EQT Harris Well access road to the intersection with Waterdam Road in Franklin Township, for an approximate total distance of 15,660 feet, including 4,600 feet in Franklin Township. Two bids (w/Bid Bond) were received for the project.
