Meeting Minutes

June 6, 2023

CALL TO ORDER: At 5:30 PM, Vice-President Pam Phillips called the meeting of the Jefferson Borough Council to order in the Morgan Township Municipal Office Building at 1019 Third Street, Mather, Greene County, Pennsylvania. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL: Vice-President Pam Phillips and Mayor Dale Harshman were present. Council members Lance Sahady, Jeffrey Coneybeer and Joshua Forman were also present.
