## **MINUTES**

Walter Stout, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

In attendance were Supervisors Walter Stout, Charles Hickman, Troy Smith; and Secretary Diane Headlee. Also in attendance were several interested township residents.

- I. Requests to Address the Board/Public Comment None
- II Correspondence and Reports
  - 1. Received Correspondence:
    - Mr. Stout reported he had received in an email this morning, the test results of the water samples taken at various locations along Ruff Creek following Consol's drill pit overflow on the Cole Farm. The results took about 3 to 4 weeks to get back to us as DEP sends all water samples to Harrisburg for lab testing. If anyone wants to look at it you are welcome to do so. As would be expected, the chemical levels were noticeably higher at the discharge site and they went back to normal going downstream. The test results were also sent to Rick Morris and Rita Martin.

    - There were no items for discussion or needing action so the February 6th meeting was cancelled.

    - No meeting. There will be a meeting scheduled soon for a special exception that is being submitted.

#### d. Application For Payment – Swede Construction Corp. (GC) – App. #4-Final

The Chairman asked the Board to consider a motion to approve Application for Payment #4 (Final), received from Swede Construction Corp, the General Contractor on the Park rehabilitation project, in the amount of \$7,097.00, to be paid contingent upon the successful completion and approval by the architect of the punch list items. The payment will be funded by the Impact fee fund, as part of the required match of the DCNR grant received for the project. The motion was made by Charles Hickman and seconded by Walter Stout. Motion carried.

e. Application For Payment – TBI Contracting, Inc. – App. #1-Final

The Chairman asked the Board to consider a motion to approve Application for Payment #1-(Final), received from TBI Contracting, Inc, the Plumbing Contractor on the Park Rehabilitation project, in the amount of \$27,030.00, to be paid contingent upon the successful completion and approval by the architect of the punch list items. The payment will be fully funded by the DCNR grant monies received for the project. The application reflects a contract completion of 100%. The motion was made by Troy Smith and seconded by Charles Hickman. Motion carried.

f. Application For Payment – Cast & Baker Corp. – App. #2

The Chairman asked the Board to consider a motion to approve Application for Payment #2, received from Cast and Baker Corp, the contractor on the Long Mile Road Landslide Repair Project, in the amount of \$4,000.00, to be paid from the Impact Fee Fund upon approval by the project engineer, Mike Schumaker of CEC. The motion was made by Charles Hickman and seconded by Walter Stout. Motion carried.

    - 1. <u>Heavy Hauling Agreement Consol PA Coal Company</u>

The Chairman asked the Board to consider a motion to approve three Heavy Hauling Agreements, all with an effective date of February 1, 2020 to February 1, 2021, with Consol PA Coal Company, for Brooks Hollow Road (T-547), Morris Road (T-414) and Tower Road (T-411), for a fee of \$300.00 per roadway, pursuant to the Schedule of Fees. - Mr. Stout began a conversation regarding the status of the Alamo Machete boom arm mower, explaining we have had both the boom arm and mower repaired and rebuilt numerous times during the last three years and the equipment has simply reached the end of its useful life. The Chairman asked the Board to consider a motion to advertise for a new Boom Arm Mower to be installed on the Case tractor, which is currently being over-hauled. The motion was made by Troy Smith and seconded by Charles Hickman to prepare specifications and advertise for a new boom-arm mower to be installed on our existing tractor. The motion carried.
