The Greene County Prison Board meeting was brought to order at 11:45 am by Chairman Mike Belding in the first-floor meeting room of the County office building. Others in attendance were: Commissioner Betsy McClure, Ami Cree, Jeff Marshall, and Sarah Penich.

On conference call, Warden John Kingston, District Attorney Dave Russo, and Judge Dayich.

MOTIONS

1. Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Controller Ami Cree the second to approve the minutes from the March 19th 2020 Prison Board meeting. Vote unanimous.

SECURITY

1. There was four (4) reportable Extraordinary Occurrence Report (EOR) submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections for the Month of March 2020.
2. The facility issued fourteen (14) major misconducts and eighteen (18) minor misconducts for the month of March 2020.

TREATMENT

1. Prior to the restriction of entrance of visitors to the facility, the following programs or sessions were conducted for the Month of March.

Two (2) Landmark Baptist Church Bible Study classes, One Axiom Family session, two (2) Walk with Jesus Daily (WWJD) groups, One (1) Alcoholics Anonymous group, Two (2) Drug and Alcohol assessments, and Two (2) Mental Health assessments.

STAFFING AND TRAINING

1. We have suspended all scheduled annual training until further notice.

MAINTENANCE

1. The men's work crew continues to work on grounds and within the facility.

FINANCIAL REPORT

1. Fayette County owes \$3,100.00 for March 2020 and currently owes \$1,050.00 for the month of April.
2. Deposits totaling \$880.00 have been made with the Treasurer's Office for March with \$ 480.00 for work release and \$400.00 for weekend fees.
3. The March assessed revenue report generated from the Greene County Central Booking Center was \$ 4,025.00 with an actual paid return of \$ 2,399.37
